•	<ul> <li>Creation and implementation of Regional Training Grant – Shilah/Herb/Kyle- Shilah gave an overview. The grants are now available for SWCDs and WCs; maybe someday for land trusts and other organizations. There are 3 levels of funding and no match is required. The next deadline is 7/31/19. OCEAN has \$5000 available for these grants.</li> </ul>								
•	<ul> <li>Rogue Siskiyou Riparian Restoration Workshop – Clint developed this regional training because it was one of the outcomes in the survey from last years riparian training at Connect. Funding was from the Oregon Community Foundation. ODA and NRCS helped him develop the training. It took 9 months of planning for the 2 day training. Mornings were inside with afternoon tours of sites at various stages of restoration. 54 attendees from 33 organizations. He will share a 2 page summary with the group.</li> </ul>								
•	<ul> <li>Strategic Planning 2019 – Jeremy discussed the plan of having the strategic planning session prior to Connect and that this was foiled by weather that closed parts of I84. Rescheduled for May. They will review the business plan, identify new services, discuss ways to expand capacity, identify funding options, and discuss ways to improve communications.</li> </ul>								
•	<ul> <li>OrCP drafting 2019-2021 Work Plan – Jeremy discussed the \$550,000 in funding available for next biennium. In the current and past years, OCEAN has only received \$30,000 for the biennium. This is less than the partnership spent on their current press person. Connect keeps growing and next year is a joint conference. The OCEAN Board is looking for more support from the partnership.</li> </ul>

OCEAN's seat on OACD, but now allow up to 3 District Managers on the OACD Board. Discussions with OACD Board members seem to indicate that this									
would continue to allow staff to be represented to OACD. Some members of OCEAN would prefer to have a say in their representative and, with the exception of DMs, SWCD staff are not members and have no vote with OACD. Some were frustrated with the limited time to review the draft bylaws (10 days) and wonder why there is such a rush to get them passed. Comments that were submitted were not incorporated into the draft. Some OCEAN members feel the bylaws vote should be postponed until OACD's November meeting. Jeremy said he will ask the vote to be postponed. If the vote goes forward, Tami motioned and Lisa Kilders seconded a motion to vote no which passed unanimously.
